

READ ACTS 4:1-20.

- As you reflect on what happened in Jerusalem after Jesus' resurrection, what stands out to you the most? How does it impact you to realize that your faith today is part of the ongoing evidence of what Peter and John witnessed over 2,000 years ago?
- How do you think the way you live provides evidence of Jesus to those around you whether it's your children, neighbors, or coworkers? How might their faith be influenced by what they see and hear in your life?
- Discuss the statement: "What your child thinks God thinks when God thinks about them is what drives what comes into your child's mind when they think about God." If this is true, what picture of God are you are painting for your child(ren) through your words and actions? What image of God comes to your mind – and what do you think comes to theirs? What is one change you can make to better reflect God's love, grace, and truth?
- If trust is the currency of relationship and influence, would you say you are making deposits or running on empty when it comes to your children, neighbors, or coworkers? Why? What is **one intentional step** you can take this week to build trust in these relationships?
