

## **SERMON QUESTIONS**

### **DOES THE PASSAGE SAY ABOUT MY SINFUL NATURE?**

- How did Adam & Eve fail in the garden? In what ways are you similar to Adam and Eve?
- When you fail, do you run and hide from the Lord, or do you run and quickly confess? Why?

### **WHAT DOES THE PASSAGE SAY ABOUT GOD?**

- Characterize God's confrontation of Adam & Eve. Is it what you would expect? How do you think Adam & Eve felt following this?
- Read Genesis 3:21. How did God cover up Adam & Eve's shame? What does this teach us about God? About sacrifice? Discuss how this symbolizes how God's people need a covering for their sin through the death of Jesus Christ.

### **HOW DOES THE PASSAGE POINT TO JESUS?**

- Read Genesis 3:15. In what way does this help us understand what the Bible / Gospel is all about? How should this affect how we read the Bible?
- Read 1 Cor. 15:22, "For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive." Discuss how amazing the grace of God is and ways in which his mercy and kindness should lead us to turn from our sinful nature. How does this passage help you to love, trust, and worship Jesus more fully?

### **HOW DOES GOD WANT ME TO RESPOND?**

- Pastor Ted challenged us to spend time in prayer and HEAR God our Father asking:
  1. "Where are you?"
  2. "Who are you listening to?"
  3. "Is there anything you need to tell Me?"
- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any sin that you are trying to cover up. Ask God for the grace and power to run and quickly confess your sin to God. Consider sharing with your group and/or trusted friend what God reveals, so that they can pray for you.
