What Faithfulness Looks Like

Pastor Dave used three principles which he called The Three Laws of Faithfulness

- The Law of Action (get off of the couch)
- The Law of Proportion (God's expectation of us is only what He gave us)
- The Law of Reward (there is a reward to being faithful)

How can the understanding of these principles make us more faithful?

What Faithfulness Reveals

- How does our understanding of God and His character correlate with our faithfulness?
- How does our faithfulness impact those around us?

- What is the difference between a talent and a skill?
- In contrast to this world that emphasizes equality, what do we learn about God in regards to what the master did with the bag of gold from the unfaithful servant?
